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Important Information

Starting Back To School - August 2018

- Nursery and Primary 1 pupils have already had their starting information. This was given to all parents and carers at an induction meeting held in June.
- School will start back for all other pupils on **Tuesday 28**th **August** at normal time. Children will finish at **12pm** on Tues 28th, Wed 29th and Thurs 30th August.
- Children will then finish at normal finishing time on Friday 31st August 2018.

SLIGHT CHANGE IN SCHOOL TIMINGS

• From the start of the next academic year, Primary 5 – Primary 7 pupils will finish school **every Friday afternoon at 2:10pm**. Internal break timings will be adjusted throughout the school week to ensure that no overall teaching time is lost for these pupils. Finish times for P1 – P4 pupils remain unchanged. To confirm, school finishing times on a Friday are as follows:

School Uniform

• In preparation for returning to school, please ensure that your child has the correct full school uniform. Just a reminder that training shoes are not allowed to be worn outside of PE lessons. Black school shoes should be worn at all other times - please ensure that all items are labelled with your child's name.

Equipment

 All children will have received a list of equipment and resources they will need when they start back to school. I would be very grateful if children could bring all their equipment with them on their first day back to school – please ensure that all items are labelled with your child's name.



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Breakfast Club

Breakfast club will be available again this academic year. The cost for breakfast club will, initially, remain at £1.75 per session. As this cost has not increased within the last year, I will need to keep it under review as we move forward. Children can attend breakfast club from 8:00am each morning, however, children must arrive before 8:30am in order to be served a breakfast.

Parents are reminded that, on the first day of attendance at breakfast club, a permission slip must be signed.

School Dinners

Children are able to avail of school dinners on a daily basis. Our 5-star canteen provides delicious meals for all our children. The cost of school dinners is set by the Education Authority. At present they cost £2.60 per day.

Payment should be sent into school on a Monday morning for the total amount for the coming week. This allows staff to gauge numbers as accurately as possible.

Money Envelopes

We know it can be difficult trying to find spare envelopes around the house when sending money into school. To make life a little easier, you can purchase a booklet of money envelopes from the school office for £2.50. These envelopes, a little like Church collection envelopes, can be used for dinner money, milk money, payment for trips etc. Simply call into the school office if you would like to purchase these.

<u>After School Activity Club – Kids' Cave</u>

Our after school activity club, Kids' Cave, will continue to operate next academic year for all our pupils. This club is open daily, from 2pm – 5:30pm (5:00pm on a Friday) at a cost of £4:50 per hour. Booking forms are available from the school office or from the Kids' Cave room and should be returned on a Thursday, along with payment, for the next week.

TUES 28TH, WED 29TH & THURS 30TH AUGUST DEAL

Kids' Cave will be available from 12pm on these days. If you book your child in for 4 hours or more (from 12pm to after 3pm) the cost will be a flat rate of £15 per child – not £4.50 per hour – saving £12 if your child stays until 5:30pm. Speak with Mrs Evans or Mrs Ervine when collecting your child for payment for the first week. The rate remains £4.50 per hour if you would like your child to stay between 1 and 3 hours.
