

PRIMARY 1 RE-OPENING PLANS

SUBJECT TO CHANGE IF DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION ISSUE UPDATED GUIDANCE.

Guidance correct at 30th June 2020

Given the most recent guidance from the Department, we will **be unable to open school at full capacity in the new school year.** The current restriction of distancing children 1m from each other and 2m from the class teacher means that we will only be able to return most of our classes on a part-time basis for face-to-face teaching, with home/remote learning taking place for the rest of the week.

This is not ideal! All staff at VPS want the children back in school full time, however, we must work within the guidance given to us from the Department of Education.

The following pages gives you more details about how we will operate a return.

INFORMATION FOR PUPILS GOING INTO PRIMARY 1

- The information evening for P1 parents on Tuesday 25th August, 7pm-8pm, will still be going ahead. In order to distance within our school hall, please ensure that children do not attend and that only 1 adult from each family attends. More detailed information about starting times etc will be given at this meeting in relation to P1.
- Due to the Department of Education requesting that schools ensure children remain 1m apart when at school, we are unable to bring all children back on a full time basis. Children will be split into 2 groups:
 YELLOW GROUP and GREEN GROUP. THIS WILL BEGIN ON MONDAY 31ST AUGUST.
- YELLOW GROUP will attend school on Monday and Tuesday (9.15am 11.45am) and work from home on a Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.
- GREEN GROUP will work from home on a Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday and will attend school on a Thursday and Friday (9.15am – 11.45am).
- A member of school staff will contact you to let you know what coloured group your child is in. This will take place, via text message, during July.
- We will ensure that siblings attend school on the same days.
- P1 children will come into school and exit school via the P1 entrance.
 There will be members of staff on the playground to give directions.
